The University of Piraeus invites students of secondary education and university students from Greece and the member countries of the Erasmus+ KA3 T4E-Teachers4Europe: setting an Agora for Democratic Culture project to participate in Students' Rhetoric Symposium under the title "Global Citizen: Supporting Sustainable Cities and Communities", which will be held in Piraeus and Elefsina from 29 to 30 August 2022.

The Student Rhetoric Symposium will be implemented in collaboration with the Research Center of the University of Piraeus, the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs, the Hellenic Association for the Promotion of Rhetoric in Education, the School Partnership for Democracy in Education - EUDEC Greece, the ASPnet UNESCO schools' network, the MUN Unipi, the Erasmus Student Network, University of Piraeus, the Young European Federalists (JEF)-Piraeus and the Municipality of Elefsina.

Up to fifty high school students (15 - 18 year old) and university students (18-22 year old) will participate in rhetorical games, impromptu and persuasive speech in particular. The official language is English.
